

Made in America Art Contest

In October, the Washington Symphony Orchestra will present "Made in America," a concert that will explore American music in all of its forms. The WSO is inviting all children in grades K through 6 to draw a picture with the theme "Made in America." What does "Made in America" mean to you? The concert will feature music by George Gershwin, Billy Strayhorn, Henry Mancini and Aaron Copeland, among others—you can listen to their music for inspiration while you create your image for the contest!

RULES:

- 1. Only 2-dimensional art is accepted.
- 2. Any medium can be used, including one or more of the following: crayons, markers, colored pencils, watercolor, tempera, acrylic.
- 3. Work directly on heavy white paper or poster board.
- 4. Artwork must not exceed 11" x 17."
- 5. Please do not write your name on the front of the artwork--attach the form (see below) to the back.
- 6. Artwork is entered at your own risk. All possible care will be taken to secure work. However, the WSO is not responsible for damage or loss to any entry.

One winner will be chosen by a WSO panel of judges at the end of the October 15 concert. Artwork will be on display at the October 15 concert. Another winner will be chosen by online voting the week after the concert. Both winners will receive a gift card. Entrants need not be from Washington County. Artwork **must be received** by the WSO by Friday, October 14 at 5 p.m. Entries can be hand-delivered or mailed to the WSO office at 11 South College Street, Washington, PA 15301. Questions?
