

- Eligibility: Any instrumentalist or classical vocalist high school age or younger
Residency: **The performer must be a resident of Washington County, PA**
Audition piece: A classical composition (or movement) for solo & orchestra (no transcriptions)
Music: Performer must provide 3 copies of the audition music
This music should not be mailed with the application. Please bring it with you to the competition.
Accompanist: Performer must provide an accompanist
Judges: WSO Music Director, Yugo Ikach, and orchestra members.
Prize: Due to the generosity of a WSO board member, the prize will be \$1,000. The winner will perform with the WSO at the "Abracadabra" concert on Saturday, May 5, 2018, 8 p.m.
All entrants will be notified of status prior to the competition. All competitors will be notified of the winner by mail, along with comments by the judges.
