

- Eligibility: Any high school age instrumentalist (9th through 12th grades)
Residency: **The performer must be a resident of Washington County, PA**
Audition piece: A classical composition (or movement) for solo & orchestra (no transcriptions)
Music: Performer must provide 3 copies of the audition music
This music should not be mailed with the application. Please bring it with you to the competition.
Accompanist: Performer must provide an accompanist
Judges: WSO Music Director, Yugo Ikach, and orchestra members.
Prize: A \$500 cash prize will be awarded to the winner.
Performance: The winner will perform with the WSO (location TBD) on Saturday, May 7, 2022, 7:30 p.m.
All entrants will be notified of status prior to the competition. Competition date will be set once all applications are received. All competitors will be notified of the winner by email, along with comments by the judges.
